

## Data protection information

This data protection information applies to data processing within the Fraunhofer Visitors' Book. The controller – in means of data protection law – is the “Fraunhofer-Gesellschaft zur Förderung der angewandten Forschung e.V.”, Hansastraße 27 c, 80686 Munich, for their Fraunhofer-Institute for Energy Economics and Energy System Technology, Joseph-Beuys-Str. 8, 34117 Kassel (hereinafter Fraunhofer IEE).

You can contact our data protection officer directly at any time.

As a visitor of Fraunhofer-IEE you will be registered in the visitor book. Usually your name, your employer, and the date, time and reason for your visit are recorded. In times when an epidemic or pandemic makes it necessary to trace infection chains, we also collect your contact information (optionally your telephone number or your e-mail address or your postal address. If you wish, you can also provide us with more than one of the above mentioned contact information). The data processing is based on our legitimate interest in the enforcement of our house rules (Art. 6 (1) lit. f DSGVO) and - for the additional data processing in times of an epidemic or pandemic - in the tracing of chains of infection for the protection of our employees and visitors.

You have the following rights with regard to your personal data that is being processed by us:

- Right to information,
- Right to correction or deletion,
- Right to restrict the processing,
- Right to data portability

**You also have the right to object at any time, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to the processing of your personal data pursuant to Article 6 (1) lit. f GDPR (data processing for the purposes of the legitimate interests).** Once you file an objection, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for processing which override your interests, rights and freedoms, or unless the processing serves the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims. To the extent that your objection addresses the processing of data for direct advertising, we will stop the processing immediately. In this case, citing a special situation is not required. This shall also apply to profiling in as far as it relates to such direct advertising. You also have the right to complain to a data protection supervisory authority about our processing of your personal data.

Your personal data will be erased after 30 days, unless legal storage obligations oblige us to store the data longer.
